


## FIND YOUR RING SIZE


- 1. Before printing, make sure that page scaling is set to "None" in your print dialog box.
- 2. After printing, use a ruler to measure the bar on the left. It must be exactly 30 mm long.
- **3. Ring measurements are very precise.** Follow instructions carefully and repeat several times to obtain an accurate measurement.

## **OPTION 1: MEASURE CURRENT RING**

- 1. Choose a ring that properly fits the finger you are purchasing the ring for.
- 2. Lay the ring on top of the circles below, finding the circle that best matches the inside edge of the ring, known as the ring diameter.



Tip: If your ring diamater is between two sizes, choose the larger size.



## **OPTION 2:** Measure your finger

- 1. Cut out the ring sizer below.
- 2. Wrap the sizer tightly around the widest part of the intended finger.
- 3. Insert the pointed end of the sizer through the slit, making sure you can read the numbers.
- 4. The number that lines up with the slit is your ring size. Measure your finger several times to ensure accuracy.

Tip: It is best to measure your finger at the end of the day. Avoid measuring your finger when you are cold or damp.
