

## Confirm Printing Paper Size



Millemeters

- 1. Before printing, make sure that page scaling is set to "None" in your print dialog box.
- 2. After printing, use a ruler to measure the bar on the left. It must be exactly 30 mm long.
- 3. Ring measurements are very precise. Follow instructions carefully and repeat several times to obtain an accurate measurement.


## **OPTION 1: MEASURE CURRENT RING**

- 1. Choose a ring that properly fits the finger you are purchasing the ring for.
- Lay the ring on top of the circles below, finding the circle that best matches the inside edge of the ring, known as the ring diameter.

THE INSIDE EDGE OF THE RING

Tip: If your ring diamater is between two sizes, choose the larger size.



## OPTION 2: MEASURE YOUR FINGER

- 1. Cut out the ring sizer below.
- 2. Wrap the sizer tightly around the widest part of the intended finger.
- 3. Insert the pointed end of the sizer through the slit, making sure you can read the numbers.
- 4. The number that lines up with the slit is your ring size. Measure your finger several times to ensure accuracy.

Tip: It is best to measure your finger at the end of the day. Avoid measuring your finger when you are cold or damp.
